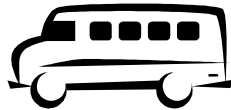

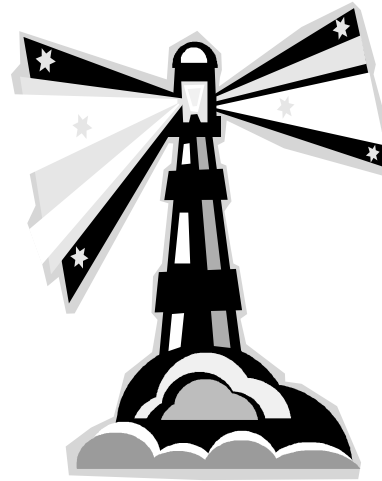

A Message from Chad

The Lord blessed us during Sunday worship this week. Though it was a difficult subject matter, I enjoyed preparing and delivering that sermon. I appreciate all the positive comments and encouragement I received. We will take a break from 1 Timothy for the next three weeks as I will shift to a three-week sermon series on how to talk about the Christian faith and the gospel when it comes up in ordinary conversation. Several have approached me about some nuts and bolts teaching on evangelism. So, we will do this in conjunction with the 3 Circles material, and these sermons will go hand in hand with the training.

3 Circles Training - Do you know how to tell others about the hope you have in Christ Jesus. Our 3 Circles training will help you learn how to tell others about the grace and forgiveness you have experienced. Training will take place Sept. 10, Sept. 24, Oct. 1, and Oct. 8 during the evening service at 6 p.m. Even if you don't regularly attend Sunday nights (and you know I don't pester people to attend all the meetings of the church), **I expect everyone to attend this training, even if you know all there is to know about evangelism!**

Engage Conference - On October 15, our church will be hosting the BGCT Engage Evangelism Conference. All local churches will be invited to attend. This will be an incredible night of ministry.

Dr. Mike Satterfield, African American Evangelism Specialist with the BGCT, is an amazing preacher. He will be featured in our main service. FBCO Ensemble will lead worship. The following break-out classes will be offered:

- Pathway to Spiritual Breakthrough (Charles Wilson, Pastor, Central Baptist Church, Crandall, TX) Focus: Prayer and fasting;
 - Developing an outreach strategy for today's culture. (Dan Wooldridge, Pastor, Crestview Baptist Church, Georgetown, TX) Focus: Outreach ministry in today's culture;
 - 3-Circles Spiritual Conversation Guide (Joshua del Risco, Evangelism Lead, BGCT) Focus: Personal evangelism;
 - Beginning Steps (Phil Miller, Discipleship Lead, BGCT) Focus: Discipleship of new believers & development of a discipleship ministry;
 - 4XFour Challenge (Greg Wallace, author of the 4xFour Challenge) Focus: Catalytic process for continued church growth.
- Additionally, Preston Cave, Student Pastor at Lakeside Baptist Church in Granbury, Texas, will be leading the youth workers' and parents' breakout. Put this on your calendar now.

Also, remember **March for Jesus** on October 7, and **FBCO Fall Festival** on October 29.

Don't forget that this year that we are going to make an effort as a church to attend all the home games for the Cubs. There are only four home Varsity games this year (Sept. 8, Sept 29, Oct. 20, Nov. 3). Please come cheer on the football team, the cheerleaders, and the band.
