A Message from Jaden

"For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the basic principles of the oracles of God. You need milk, not solid food, for everyone who lives on milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, since he is a child. But solid food is for the mature, for those who have their powers of discernment trained by constant practice to distinguish good from evil." Hebrews 5:12-14

This section of Hebrews is a sobering reminder that we <u>all</u> need to be growing in our knowledge of the Bible. The thing that identifies a child here is not only that they drink milk, but that they are <u>unskilled</u> in the word of righteousness. If you want to grow and experience deeper intimacy with God, or if you want to be used <u>mightily</u> for the kingdom, you must become skilled in the Word by reading it, trusting what it says, and moving in obedience to it.

I have a sweet, little baby living in my house right now and to watch her sit on her mother's lap and drink milk is pretty normal and cute. If she was doing the same thing at 3 years old, that image gets a little strange... Something's not quite right there. She should definitely be exclusively eating solid food by the age of 3.

I would like to remind all readers who have been born again for more than a couple years to press on and seek to feed on the deeper truths of scripture. Grow up in Christ more and more each day by studying scripture, believing it, and walking it out. The Word isn't just something you needed once upon a time, and it's not just something you need on Sundays. It is something you need to chew on daily.
